



## Competition ‘Who’s the best pastor?’

### What’s that?

A varied competitive game for children. Participants pay a sum x to take part. The winner receives, for example, 25% of the jackpot, and the rest of the sum collected goes to the ETF.

### Why?

At the ETF, students are trained, for example, to become pastors. During this competition, in a playful way, the children become familiar with the job of a pastor. All sorts of things are involved in winning this competition. Who can run fast, point out countries on a map, read beautifully and speak well?

### How?

1. Download the ETF logo and make a folder or poster for the competition, ‘Who’s the best pastor?’
2. Send a mail with your idea and the date of the competition to [info@etf.edu](mailto:info@etf.edu).
3. Explain to the children, and possibly the parents, what the ETF is and why the ETF is the good cause for the competition.
4. Form a jury (of two or three teachers) who will keep the score and give points.
5. The competition consists of three rounds (see separate page). The child with the best total score wins the competition. Of course you can think up additional rounds yourself.

## Competition 'Who's the best pastor?' (part 2)

### The competition

#### 1st round: **Rushing to see an elderly lady**

As a pastor, you sometimes have to jump out of bed really quickly to go to a Church member. Today one of your dearest Church members is sick in bed. Mrs Tufts feels really ill and wants you to pray with her. You jump out of bed and run as quickly as possible to Mrs Tufts! Who is the first to reach the elderly lady?

1st place = 3 points

2nd place = 1 point

#### 2nd round: **Bible reading**

A pastor has to preach almost every Sunday. That's quite difficult. For a good sermon, a Bible passage is read out. Who is best at reading the Bible verses aloud? (Use Matt. 18: 1-5 or choose a Bible passage yourself.)

1st place = 3 points

2nd place = 1 point

#### 3rd round: **Wedding celebration**

An enjoyable job for pastors is that they sometimes get to marry people. For this round, you need a bride and groom (parents, teachers or even classmates). Who can conduct the best wedding? You're not allowed to make it longer than 3 minutes.

1st place = 3 points

2nd place = 1 point

#### If there is a draw, a deciding round:

##### **Where is Israel?**

As a pastor, you know a lot about Jesus. You know what He did and where He lived. (Use a geographical map.) Where did Jesus live when He was on the earth? (The participants have to face the other way so that they cannot see where their fellow players are pointing.)

1st place = winner
